PINHOLE LEAKS IN COPPER WATER LINES



A neighbor has alerted us to the fact that the copper water lines in our homes may be developing pinhole leaks. When a pinhole leak occurs, it may cause a slow leak that will take weeks or months to find, or a large leak with immediate damage. This problem is happening here in Louisville, as well as elsewhere around the country and the world, and there appears to be no scientific consensus on the cause or causes. Our neighbor suggests Googling "pinhole leaks copper water lines" to see what's being written about the problem. In the meantime she suggests we take a look at our water lines where visible, to see if they show evidence of damage. The photo shows a copper water line with a pinhole leak. Could be a reason to call the plumber.
